Nottinghamshire Historic Environment Record on the Heritage Gateway

The Nottinghamshire HER contains data on historic features of the County. It does not cover the area of NottinghamCity.

The HER consists of a database containing records of monuments, buildings, finds, archaeological events and sources. It also contains information on nationally important designated sites (Scheduled Monuments, Listed Buildings, Registered Parks and Gardens and Registered Battlefields) and locally designated conservation areas. The HER also holds reports, articles, books and journals, as well as associated files, aerial photographs, slides and photographs.

A sub-set of the digital data is being made available via the Heritage Gateway. This includes monuments and buildings, but excludes events and some entries that are very poorly located. Please be aware that the HER database is constantly being updated and the version which is available via the Gateway will be updated from time to time, so it may be somewhat out of date. For these reasons the version on the Heritage Gateway is not suitable for the purposes of desk-based assessments or studies associated with development, planning or land use changes. For these purposes and all other commercial enquiries, please contact the HER officer.

The information from the HER database is subject to Intellectual Property Rights, and should not be reproduced in any format without the written permission of Nottinghamshire County Council which retains copyright.

Although every reasonable effort is made to verify information held within the HER, it cannot be definitive since the HER is compiled from a variety of sources, some of which are unchecked. The HER is continually being enhanced and corrected as new information becomes available, but cannot be accountable for the accuracy of all information contained within it. Users who identify inaccuracies or omissions in the Nottinghamshire data are requested to notify the HER Officer. Similarly the HER cannot be entirely up to date as new reports and information are continually arriving and there will inevitably be some backlog.

The sites included on the Nottinghamshire HER and Heritage Gateway are part of a public record, but this does not imply public access to any of them, as many of the sites are on private land.
